Windows ¹	U-Factor must be ≤ 0.22	\$25 sqft
Attic Insulation ^{1 & 4}	Insulation must be $\geq R-60$, or cavity filled to R-49. Previous insulation $\leq R-11$	\$2.50 sqft
Floor Insulation ^{1 & 4}	Insulation must be $\geq R-30$, or cavity filled. Previous insulation $\leq R-11$	\$3.00 sqft
Wall/Sloped Ceiling Insulation ^{1 & 4}	Insulation must be $\geq R-21$, or cavity filled. Previous insulation $\leq R-4$	\$5.00 sqft
Duct Insulation ^{1 & 6}	Insulation must be $\geq R-11$. Previous insulation $\leq R-2$	\$2.50 lnft
Duct Sealing ¹	Requires 30% or more of supply ducts in unconditioned space	\$1,000
Prescriptive Air Sealing ^{1 & 4}	Attic Insulation installation required. Attic and crawl space must be sealed to BPA Specifications	\$0.15 sqft
Whole House Air Sealing ^{1, 4 & 5}	Minimum 400 CFM50 reduction using pre/post blower door testing	\$0.50 sqft
Existing Home Bundle A	Any two unique insulation measures performed at the same time with a minimum 1,000 sqft total	\$500
Existing Home Bundle B	Same requirements as Bundle A plus Whole House Air Sealing	\$2,000

Measure Caveats

1. Home must be primarily heated by natural gas. Multi-zone ductless electric heat pump cannot be present.
2. Note the following units of measure: Attic Insulation and Prescriptive Air Sealing (square feet of roof), Floor Insulation (square feet of floor), Wall/Sloped Ceiling Insulation (square feet of wall), Duct Insulation (linear feet of duct), Windows (square feet of window), Whole-Home Air Sealing (square feet of conditioned space).
3. Water-heating fuel must be primarily provided by CNGC for all water-heating incentives. Combined use of indirect, non-fired tank is acceptable for use with approved 95% AFUE Boiler where required.
4. Insulation and all air sealing measures must be performed by a CNGC qualified Trade Ally. Visit www.cngc.com/energy-efficiency for a list of qualified CNGC Trade Ally contractors in your area.
5. Requires WA Department of Commerce Combustion Safety Test Report Exhibits 9.4A and 5.S3A. https://www.cngc.com/wp-content/uploads/PDFs/Conservation/Combustion-Safety_Blower-Door_Diagnostic-Test-Report.pdf. Leakage reduction required to be verified and documented through pre and post blower door testing.
6. Ducts must be sealed prior to Duct Insulation being installed to qualify. WA Licensed HVAC contractors may install Duct Insulation and Duct Sealing.

Eligibility Requirements

- Applications must be received within 90 days of install date.
- Applications must be a Washington State CNGC customer on residential rate schedule 503 (check your CNGC bill).
- Homes must be primarily heated by natural gas to be eligible for space heating and weatherization rebate.
- All measures must be installed by a Washington State licensed contractor in good standing, excluding Exterior Entry doors, Efficient Thermostats, and Clothes Washers. These measures may be self-installed with support documentation including: copies of purchase receipts and photos of equipment sticker, or screenshot of equipment information in the smart app displaying brand, model number, and serial number.
- Efficient Thermostats, Duct Sealing, Prescriptive Air Sealing, Whole House Air Sealing, and all Bundle Measures are restricted to 1 incentive per Measure per household.
